The account book was written by his own hand, and the handwriting is very clear. The entries begin in 1750. At that date he was still a young man. The last entries of accounts proper are in 1781, but there are various memoranda, the last of which are dated in 1785. The prices speak for themselves. They are the history of transactions which occurred here in our own county, in this very town of South Kingstown, and they are an impressive object lesson, showing the difficulty of doing business with a depreciated and variable currency.
